MINISTER'S ORDER

Respecting the determination of the Maximum Fees that can be charged by a rural municipality for a permit for an overweight vehicle


The order issued September 10, 2003 respecting the determination of the Maximum Fees that can be charged by a rural municipality for a permit for an overweight vehicle is rescinded.

Issued under the Authority of Section 36.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*


Pursuant to the authority conferred on the Minister of Highways and Infrastructure by section 36.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister hereby orders that where a municipality has been authorized in writing pursuant to section 51 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997* to issue a permit under section 36 of the said Act with respect to an overweight vehicle, the fee charged for the permit shall not exceed a maximum of:

1. \$50 per single trip with the exception of a road subject to a spring road restriction order;
2. \$100 per single trip on a road subject to a spring road restriction order; and
3. \$300 for a permit allowing more than one trip in a twelve month period commencing on the date the permit is issued.

This order is effective on the 16th day of July 2018.
