APPROACH STANDARDS

Approval to construct and maintain an approach within the RM's right-of-way will be granted by the Council provided the following conditions are met:

- Only one approach is permitted per property unless approved by Council in writing.
- If the RM deems a culvert is required, the cost of the culvert and installation will be paid by the applicant. The applicant will ensure that the installation of the approach and culvert does not alter or impede the natural flow of water. The culvert will be of sufficient size (400mm or larger) to ensure proper drainage.
- The approach shall be constructed at a right (90°) angle to the road.
- The approach shall be built with a minimum slope of 5:1 with a minimum 7 meter (23 feet) road top for the safety of the travelling public. (as per the attached typical cross section)
- There must be an appropriate site distance as established by the respective Division Councillor and Public Works Superintendent.
- Any approach entering onto a gravel road must be graveled at the time of construction. The RM will not be responsible to supply the gravel.
- The RM shall be informed by the Applicant upon completion of the approach and the approach shall be subject to inspection by the Superintendent. Any deficiencies identified by the municipality in the construction of the approach shall be corrected immediately by the Applicant and if not done so within a timeframe specified by the RM, the RM shall conduct the work and charge cost of the works to the Applicant.
- A development and/or building permit will not be issued without a permanent approach in place or approach application in progress.

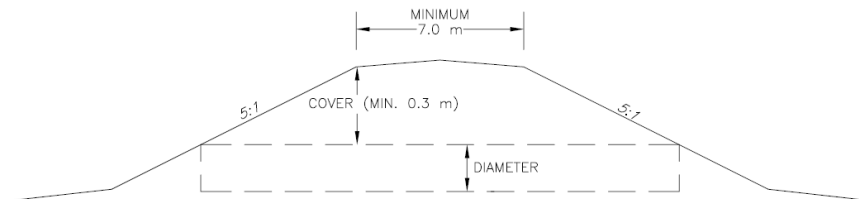
