BYLAW NO. 2-11

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE KILLING OF WILD BOARS RUNNING AT LARGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Dundurn No. 314 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. No wild boar shall run at large in the municipality, and for the purpose of this bylaw, a wild boar shall be deemed running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the wild boar, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land.
- 2. A person who owns, possesses or harbours a wild boar found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
- 3. Any person may kill a wild boar running at large on land which is owned or occupied by himself or herself.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable for any charges or penalties.
